St. Clair County Health Department Now Offering Seasonal Vaccinations

The St. Clair County Health Department and Teen Health/School based locations are now offering seasonal vaccinations for Flu, COVID-19 and RSV (Respiratory Syncytial Virus). The following products are offered (while supplies last):

Flu vaccines:

- Flucelvax for 6 months of age and older
- FluMist for healthy persons 2-49 years of age
- Fluad for 65 years of age and older

RSV vaccines:

- Abrysvo for adults 75 years of age and older and some adults 60-74 years of age with increased risk due to chronic medical conditions.
- Beyfortus/Nirsevimab monoclonal antibody for infants less than 8 months old entering first RSV season, (October through March), and some infants 8 months through 19 months meeting specific high-risk criteria.
- Abrysvo for pregnant moms 32-36 weeks gestation.

2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccine:

- Pfizer products for 6 months of age and older

Rebecca Campau, Assistant Nursing Director stated, "The Health Department has vaccines available to help protect individuals against respiratory illnesses commonly seen during the fall and winter months." Campau continued, "Now is the time to get protected. We encourage individuals to speak with their healthcare provider to determine the best options for their health needs".

Most insurance is accepted, however, check insurance plans for coverage. For uninsured adults cost will vary based on vaccine, income eligibility, and family size. Through October 30th, walk-in Wednesdays are available at the main office, 3415 28th Street, Port Huron from 8:00am - 6:00pm. For appointments call (810) 987-5300 (option 3).
