

MAACS PILOT PROJECT-EXTENSION


IT IS ORDERED:

Pursuant to Michigan Supreme Court Administrative Order 2015-9 and 31st Circuit A.O. 2015-2 this Court has participated in the MAACS pilot project. This project was established to assess the feasibility, costs, and benefits associated with certain structural reforms recommended by the Appellate Defender Commission and currently under consideration for permanent statewide implementation.

The pilot has been extended by the Michigan Supreme Court until December 31, 2017. Accordingly the 31st Circuit Court will continue to participate for the duration of the project.

For purposes of the pilot project the 31st Circuit adopts the regulations specified in Michigan Supreme Court Administrative Order 2015-9, and the attorney fee and expense policy approved by the appellate defender commission for this pilot project.
