Nomination Form

Any individual or active 4-H club may make a nomination for Volunteer of the Year or Outstanding Lifetime Volunteer award. The 4-H Volunteer of the Year and Outstanding Lifetime Volunteer are given annually to individuals. Nominees must be currently active registered 4-H leaders and must have served **less than 10 years** for Volunteer of the Year or **10 or more years** for the Outstanding Lifetime Volunteer as a St Clair County 4-H volunteer. Nominees should be adults who have made outstanding contribution to our program through their involvement and leadership in the St Clair County 4-H program. Volunteer of the Year and Outstanding Lifetime volunteer recipients will be announced at the annual leaders banquet in November. No limitation on the number of times an individual may receive these awards.
