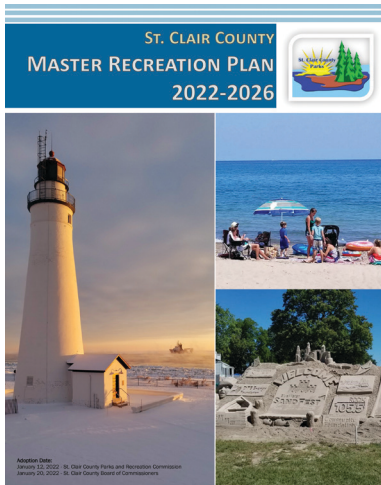

## 2022-2026 Master Recreation Plan Update

This year, the St. Clair County Parks and Recreation Commission updated its five year Master Recreation Plan. An important part of the planning process is getting community input on what facilities and services residents would like the County to provide.

## Tourism & Parks

Michigan's tourism is the 2nd largest industry, employing over 275,000 people. Visitors to St. Clair County will spend on average \$102.00 per person, per day. An overnight visitor will spend an average of \$385.00 per person. Total visitor spending in St. Clair County, in 2020, was 171 million.

Visitors are focused on nature and outdoor activities more than ever. Because of this, the Blue Water Area Convention and Visitors Bureau will get thousands of requests for recreational options throughout the year. To fulfill these requests, the St. Clair County Parks and Recreation Commission and local units of government have developed extensive biking and hiking trails in addition to beautiful waterfront and inland parks. Having a variety of updated and new outdoor amenities are vital in order to attract potential guests looking for a vacation destination.

The Blue Water Area is fortunate to have the St. Clair County Parks and Recreation Department continue creating and improving recreation options to promote tourism. Parks not only enhance the quality of life in a community, they contribute to the economic and environmental well-being of one as well.

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## To Our Readers...

The St. Clair County Board of Commissioners placed the renewal of the County Parks and Recreation millage on the August 2, 2022 primary ballot.

The requested millage rate will be 0.4944 mils (down from the original millage rate of .5 mils) for six years. If voters approve the millage renewal, the owner of a house worth \$100,000.00 will pay approximately \$25.00 per year.

The St. Clair County Parks and Recreation Commission does not receive any funding from St. Clair County's general fund.

# Local Millage Distribution



The millage will generate \$2.8 million per year for parks and recreation facilities and programs. Each year, 25% of the millage funds collected are given to the 33 local units of government (based on population) for local park and recreation projects. 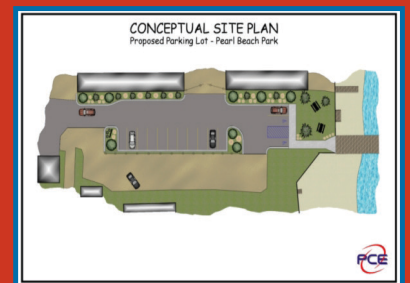
