INFORMATION

The St. Clair County Sheriff's Office is investigating a two vehicle crash that resulted in injuries to both drivers.

The preliminary investigation shows that a 2022 Mercedes Benz Sprinter van, was southbound on Wadhams Rd when the second vehicle, a 2019 Yamaha YZ450 dirt bike was traveling west on Dove Rd. and failed to yield at the stop sign. The dirt bike continued through the intersection where it collided with the side of the van. The van continued south while trying to stop and crossed to the east side of the road and overturned into the ditch. The van came to rest on its roof.

The driver of the dirt bike, a 26 year old Richmond man was initially transported to Lake Huron Medical Center by Tri- Hospital EMS before being airlifted to McLaren Macomb. He is currently listed in critical condition.

The driver and sole occupant of the van, a 25 year old Kimball Township resident, was transported to McLaren Port Huron by Tri-Hospital EMS.

Wadhams Rd was shut down for several hours during the investigation. It is not believed that alcohol was a factor. The St. Clair County Accident Investigation Team is continuing the investigation. The names of those involved are being held at this time pending further notification of family.
