## **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2007J-2**

## ST. CLAIR COUNTY COURTS WEAPONS POLICY

Pursuant to Michigan Supreme Court's Administrative Order 2001-1, the Chief Trial Judges of St. Clair County hereby approve the following administrative order to address the presence of weapons in St. Clair County Court facilities including the Courthouse in Port Huron, and the Marine City Courthouse. This order rescinds Administrative Order 2001J-1:

## IT IS ORDERED

- No weapons of any kind may be brought into the St. Clair County Court buildings including the St.
  Clair County Courthouse in Port Huron, and the Marine City Courthouse. This includes but is not
  limited to, guns, knives, brass knuckles or any other item that could be construed as a weapon,
  regardless of carrying concealed weapon (CCW) permits. This restriction does not apply to St. Clair
  County Court Security Officers, Warrant Officers, Probation Officers, Prisoner Transport Officers or
  Law Enforcement Officers conducting on duty official business inside either Court facility.
- 2. All persons and parcels are subject to a search for weapons and restricted items as a condition of entry.
- 3. Where Weapons Screening is employed, all persons entering the building through the main entrance MUST pass through the weapons screening devices. Those persons authorized to carry a weapon within the building are required to show ID before proceeding beyond the security check point.
- 4. Persons in violation of this order may be held in contempt of court.

5. Notice of this order will be conspicuously posted in all St. Clair County Court facilities.
