

When cutting the hard surface (previously matting board) to fit the picture, cut the opening approximately one to two inches smaller than the picture itself. The picture will be enveloped inside two pieces of hard surface, so the edges of your picture will not be visible.

The <u>thick</u> dark line in the illustration above is the outline for the picture. The <u>thinner</u> dark lines illustrates the hard surface. This <u>thick</u> dark line would be enveloped between or under the <u>thinner</u> dark lines.

When attaching the back piece of hard surface to the front piece of hard surface, any means in which you do this will be acceptable. Suggestion: masking tape.

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
