STATE DISASTER CONTINGENCY FUND GRANT

WHEREAS, St. Clair County, Michigan, is a political subdivision within the State of Michigan with an official Emergency Operations plan in compliance with Section 19 of the Emergency Management Act, Act 390, Public Acts of 1976, as amended; and

WHEREAS, St. Clair County, sustained severe losses of major proportions brought on by the Southeast Michigan water main break resulting in the following conditions: unsafe drinking water and boil water alert for residents in Burtchville Township, Michigan; and

WHEREAS, St. Clair County Board of Commissioners certifies that the County Emergency Operations Plan was implemented at the onset of the disaster on May 16, 2019 and all applicable disaster relief forces identified therein were exhausted on August 13, 2022; and

WHEREAS, as a direct result of the disaster, public damage and expenditures were extraordinary and place an unreasonably great financial burden on St. Clair County totaling \$6300; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT St. Clair County of Commissioners requests the Governor, authorize a grant to the County of St. Clair from the State Disaster Contingency Fund pursuant to Section 19, Act 390, Public Acts of 1976, as amended.

FURTHERMORE, Karry Hepting, Administrator/Controller, is authorized to execute for and on behalf of St. Clair County the application for financial assistance and to provide to the State any information required for that purpose.
